

## **Potable water in Shire of Manjimup**

### **MANJIMUP**

Central to the town on the South Western Highway is Manjin Park. This scenic park includes playgrounds for small children, picnic areas, a skate park, and basketball and netball courts. It is accessed by two entrances on the north and south ends of the park.

The park includes public toilets, long vehicle parking and a walkway through to the main shopping precinct (Giblett and Rose Streets).

On the east side of the north slip road into the parking area is the dump point and a small basin. This is suitable for washing up. There are no facilities for filling up Gerry cans or vans with potable water in Manjimup.

### **QUINNINUP**

The Quinninup Caravan Park offers powered sites include both potable water and grey waste disposal.

### **PEMBERTON**

Pemberton RSL Memorial Park (48 Brockman St) is in the centre of the main shopping area. There is a tap in that park, and also at the children's playground.

### **NORTHCLIFFE**

The town water supply can be accessed from a tap on the corner of Muirillup and Wheatley Coast Road next to the Pioneer Museum Playground/ Barbecue Gazebo Area.

### **WALPOLE**

Pioneer Park, on the east side of the South Coast Highway, is a scenic rest area in the centre of Walpole where the Visitor Centre is located. It offers free public toilets including a parenting room, parking, and picnic tables. The Visitor Centre is currently open from Monday to Friday from 9am to 4pm, and on Saturday 9am to 2pm.

Potable water can be sourced at the visitor centre during its opening hours. For a donation, visitors are lent the tap fitting to access the water. Visitors need their own hose to fill vans or campers.

The camp kitchen next to the visitor centre has taps for water bottles etc. (Camping is not permitted)

The Visitor Centre also offers a lock box service for Bibbulmun track & Mundabiddi users who need to post or leave food parcels at the Visitor Centre.
